## Lutheran Church of Dell Rapids Youth Code of Conduct

***In order that all people who are part of our youth/education programs may feel WELCOME, SAFE and RESPECTED, and so that everyone can enjoy an atmosphere conducive to learning, we agree that our behavior at all times:***

- *Will be respectful of others*
- *Will not disrupt others*
- *Will build up rather than tear down relationships and community*

Most youth will get along in community with others very well. But if a student behaves in ways that violates these expectations, so that their behavior causes someone else at LCDR to feel unwelcome, unsafe or disrespected, the following discipline procedure can be expected:

- ***First infraction – the teacher or guide will invite the pastor to talk one-on-one confidentially with the student, and also with the group of which he/she is a member. The incident will be reported to the youth’s parent(s) or guardian(s).***
- ***Second infraction – the student will be removed from the group/class, and the pastor will confer with the student and his/her parent(s) or guardian(s) to create an agreed-upon plan for changed behavior before returning.***
- ***Third infraction – the student will be invited to continue in the LCDR youth/education program, but apart from his/her group in independent activity/study led by the student’s parents(s) or guardian(s).***
