### From the Senior Pastor:

The theme for our Lenten worship this year of our  $150^{\text{th}}$  anniversary of our congregation's ministry is, *The Faces of Christ.* I believe that there is nothing more central, more important for our faith – than to better know the face of this man Jesus who so loves and cares for us, and whom we worship.

We've illustrated this Lenten series with art from Rembrandt's Faces of Jesus. Until the time of the seventeenth century artist Rembrandt, most artistic renderings made Jesus look like a Greek god, or a rosy-cheeked cherubic figure. Rembrandt, instead, sought to portray Christ as he more likely really was, and so (enduring criticism for doing so) employed a "Jewish model" from the Jewish quarter of Amsterdam for his dozen or so paintings depicting a "more real" Jesus.

So we too may ask, who is this very real Jesus for us? Who is the many-faceted Jesus we know from scripture? In different times and different places, what are his many faces? When and where might each of these faces appear to and for us?

In our relationship with Jesus, what most *hurts* him? What's it like to see him looking on us with *love*? When does Jesus *grieve*? What makes him *angry*, and what does that mean for us? When do we most need his *mercy*? How and when does not only his searching face, but the whole of Jesus *seek after* us? How do we imagine the *wounds* of Jesus, borne for us? How do we celebrate with a *joyful* Jesus at his Easter rising to new life – for us?

I invite you join us for these glimpses into *The Faces of Christ*, through our Lenten worship this season. May you even more deeply know him, and his life and love given for you.

#### LCDR CONGREGATION COUNCIL MINUTES JANUARY 10, 2024 (abbreviated)

<u>Consent Agenda</u>: All reports have previously been made available to members. Motion carried to approve the consent agenda (committee reports and December minutes).

Committee Reports: Education - No report for December -Fellowship/Community Outreach - No report for December -Property - No report for December - Stewardship - No report for December - **Technology** - The 1 year annual renewal for maintenance/support on the Fortinet firewall was approved. Worship - No meeting in January. They are moving forward to create a Celebration Baptismal Wall which will be located on the east wall of the Sanctuary to commemorate all the baptisms during the year. It will be lettered with "Child of God... I have called you by name; you are mine." Barb Klein has agreed to make an additional Dove (same size as what is on the banners) with the child's name. These doves will be hung on the wall and will be given to the parents on the Anniversary of our Lord's Baptism each year, starting in 2025. Baptismal Banners will be given to the parents the day of the Baptism. Youth/Family Ministry - In early December John accompanied the high school youth group at DRHS (which includes several LCDR kids) to help serve at the Banquet. On January 17 a meeting for youth in grades 8-12 is scheduled for all who want to be a part of a youth praise band experience. A pancake fundraiser is coming up on Sunday, January 21, to help raise money for confirmation camp and for those going to NOLA in the summer. Around \$700 was raised through the cookie walk. A big thank you to all who helped support this fundraiser in any way.

<u>Member Actions</u>; Brian Timperly has transferred out to a church in Brookings.

Treasurer's Report: Tom presented the year end report noting that there may still be some minor changes. Some annual payments were made. He went over the designated funds report. The line items were rearranged in an effort to make it easier to read. Motion carried to close out the year, moving technology, a line item in tech upgrades connections, copyright donation, light oil, Alice Peterson gift, Paul Odland estate, Virgil Park estate, and \$7,421.70 from the Joan Rasmussen estate (which leaves a balance of \$42,000 in it) to the general fund. Motion carried to approve the treasurer's report. Pastor's Report: Nine families attended the baptismal ceremonies last Sunday. Elder Connections will be promoting a 13-week program to address Grief Support starting after Easter. They would like to do this annually and make it open to the community as well as our members. An intergenerational spring festival event is being planned tentatively for April 7. Pastor Jeff noted that he will be doing staff performance reviews in January. We will be hosting a pastor's conference on May 9.

#### Unfinished Business:

150th Anniversary Task Force - Sue reported there are no updates.

Nominations for 2024 - Kurt reported on nominations for Council positions for 2024. Bob Harms is willing to continue another year on Stewardship. Kathleen Bongers has agreed to take another term as Secretary. Alyssa Zweifel will move to President Elect and Shanna Moke will move to President with Lee moving to Past President. Steven Munk has agreed to continue on Property. New members will be DawsonHohn for Youth Representative, Scott Zelmer for Technology, and Kayla Carstenson for Fellowship. Those names will be put on the ballot for the annual meeting. We also need four voting members to attend the Synod Assembly on May 31 and June 1. It will be held at Our Savior's in Sioux Falls. Motion carried to nominate Karen Nielson to attend the Synod Assembly. We will have to open for additional nominations at the annual meeting.

John Green print - There is no new information at this time. <u>New Business</u>:

2024 Budget - Tom reported there was growth in thank offerings in 2023, however we still need to transfer some money from estates, etc. to balance the 2023 budget. There will be roughly an 8% increase from the 2023 budget to the 2024 budget. Motion carried to approve the budget.

Prepare for the Annual Meeting - Kurt or Lee will fill in for Tom. Fellowship Hall Roof Proposal for Annual Meeting - Motion carried to approve the following resolution:

Resolution to Authorize a Capital Appeal for Repair of the Fellowship Hall Roof:

Be it resolved that the Lutheran Church of Dell Rapids in its Annual Meeting on January 28, 2024 authorize a Capital Appeal to begin in March, 2024 to raise \$80,000.00 for the purpose of repairing the Fellowship Hall roof and replacing its roofmounted Air Conditioning units, with the HVAC needed for new non-roof-mounted units, at a total expected cost of approximately \$130,000.00; to utilize designated funds of approximately \$50,000.00 for roof repair; to let bids for the project as soon as possible; and to return to the congregation for approval to expend funds and commence the project in 2024.

Executive Session: The Council moved to executive session at 10:11 p.m. and came out at 10:35. Motion carried to move forward with advertising for an administrative assistant for 32 hours a week. Announcements: Next meeting February 21 at 7:00 p.m.

Committee Reports are due by noon on Monday February 19

#### From the Associate in Ministry:



After the death of their husbands, Theresa Bokker and Sheri Holt searched out a place to find help dealing with their grief. There were no grief support groups in Dell Rapids, and they were led to Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Sioux Falls, where there was a **Grief Share** group led by Pastor Amy Martinell.

In my conversations with each of them, Theresa and Sheri both found the Sioux Falls group to be meaningful and helpful, so I arranged a meeting with Pastor Amy to talk about the possibility of offering **Grief Share** here at LCDR.

With encouragement from Pastor Amy, Pastor Jeff, and our church council, we are proceeding with plans to offer the 13-week series beginning in April. It is our hope that this will be offered annually and is intended for the whole Dell Rapids community.

**Grief Share** is a Christ-centered grief recovery ministry. The hope is that together, grieving people can journey from mourning into joy. A **Grief Share** counselor says about the process, "Healing happens in the context of finding others who can help you. A GriefShare group is a safe place to find support."

Bringing **Grief Share** to LCDR and the surrounding community is also an outreach ministry, as, historically half of those who attend **Grief Share** groups are either not members of the sponsoring church or not active in a church at all.

**Grief Share** meetings will Start on April 3<sup>rd</sup> from 6:00 until 7:30 pm. Attendees are welcome to come early to share our Simple Suppers. Please invite anyone you know who is still on their journey through grief, whether the loss is very recent or perhaps years ago. **Grief Share** is for both men and women grieving the loss of any loved one. I will be leading the group and I look forward to the journey.





#### Meals on Wheels

Please check your March calendar to determine which days you could help deliver Meals on Wheels to Dell Rapids residents who are in need of this service.

- ⇒ Pick up the noon meals at the WEST door of Dells Nursing and Rehab Center between 10:45 am— 11:00 AM. You will also receive a list of guests and their addresses (typically between 10-16 meals).
- $\Rightarrow$  Meals will be placed at the doorsteps (on a box, chair, table outside of the recipient's door) to eliminate person to person contact during delivery. Please knock on the door to announce the meal, but you do not need to wait for an answer.
- ⇒ You are encouraged to use hand sanitizer, gloves or wash hands before and after delivery.
- $\Rightarrow$  That's it. It usually takes approximately 45 minutes to complete the task.

#### Feeding South Dakota Backpack Program

LCDR's commitment to Meals on Wheels also includes a commitment to the **Backpack Program** for elementary school children. Every Tuesday/Wednesday in March we need a volunteer to pick up the empty Back packs on Tuesday, drop those back packs to Feeding SD on Wednesday that same week and then deliver the full totes back to Dells Elementary that same day.
